

BUTTERFLY WITH 'DAISY PICOTS'

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This butterfly is worked in two rows.

Abbreviations: R. = ring dds = daisy picot p = picot cl = close ring
DNRW = do not reverse work SLT = shoe lace trick RW = reverse work
CH = chain += join sj = shuttle join



Wind two shuttles with contrasting coloured size 20 threads about 2 metres on each shuttle

Knot the threads loosely leaving 6 inch ends

ROW 1

Start the ring using shuttle 1
(shuttle 2 is used to reverse tat the 'daisy picots')

R.A 2, dds (7, p, 5, p, 2)
2, dds (2, p, 4, p, 6)
3, dds (6, p, 4, p, 2)
2, dds (2, p, 5, p, 7)
2, cl DNRW, SLT

ROW 2

In this row the 2nd shuttle is used as a ball thread

Right upper wing

CH. 10, RW
R.B 6, + to 1st picot on the top 'daisy picot',
6, cl, RW
CH. 3, (p, 3) X 5, RW
R.C 6, + to same picot as ring 'B', 6, cl, RW
CH. 8, p, 2, sj to last picot on the top
'daisy picot' AND to the 1st picot on the lower 'daisy picot'

Right lower wing

CH. 2, + to picot on the chain just worked, 5, sj to free picot on 'daisy picot', DNRW
R.D is a mock ring, worked as a chain CH. 5, p, 5, sj to same picot as the previous sj
CH. 10 sj to the thread between the two lower 'daisy picots'.

Left lower wing

CH. 10, sj to 1st picot on the lower 'daisy picot' DNRW
R.E is a chain CH. 5, p, 5, sj to same picot as last sj
CH. 5, p, 2 sj to free picot on the lower 'daisy picot' AND the 1st 'daisy picot'
on the upper 'daisy picot'

Left upper wing

CH. 2, + to the picot on the chain just worked, 8, RW
R.F 6, + to free picot on the upper 'daisy picot', 6, cl, RW
CH. 3, (p, 3) X 5, RW
R.G 6, + to same picot as ring 'F', 6, cl, RW
CH. 10, sj to the start of the row.

Cut and knot with the two ends from the start.

Separate into pairs and make knots for the antennae.
