

Dimpled rings - Method 2

This technique is from Sue Hanson



To make the 'dimple' more defined, retain a loop in the 'core' (shuttle) thread half way along the stitches which will form the 'dimple' (like you do t the start of a SCMR). In Fig 1 there are 2 double stitches and a first half stitch before the loop is retained, and a second half and 2 double stitches after.

Join to the vsp and complete the ring following the pattern (Fig 1)

To close the ring first pull down the left side of the loop - the last stitches of the ring should move close to the stitches at the start of the ring. (Fig 2)

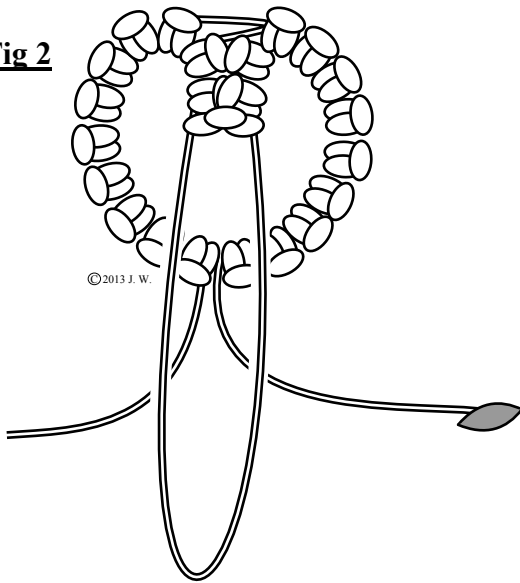

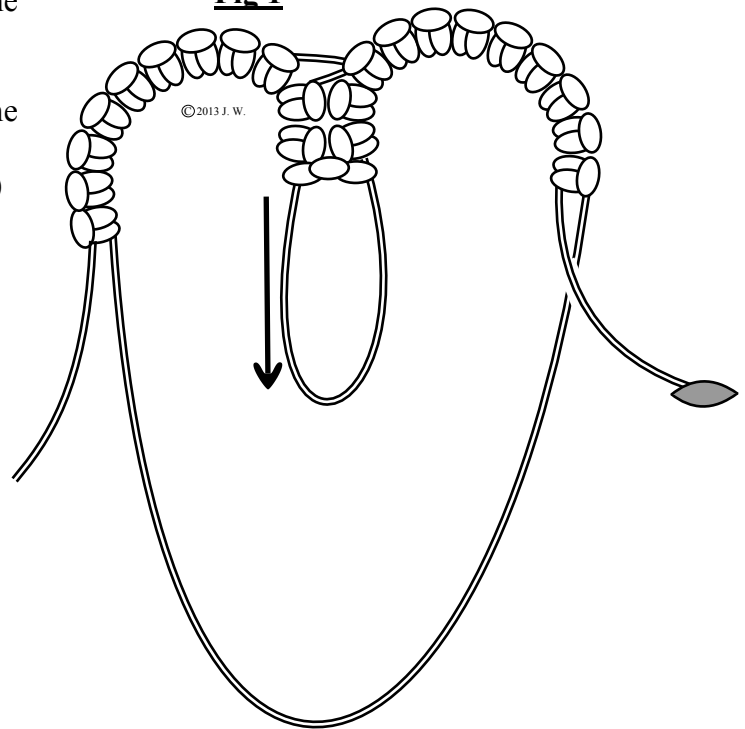
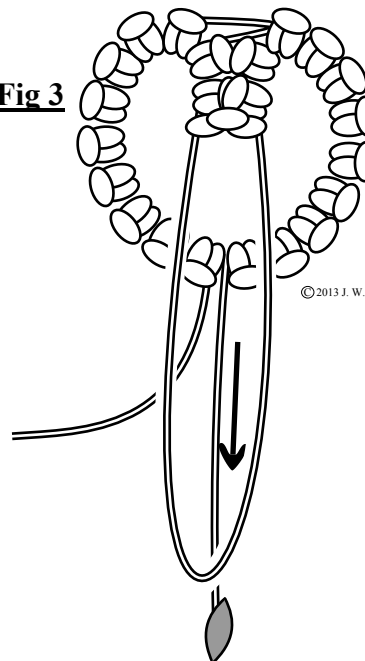

Pull on the shuttle thread (Fig 3)

The loop will disappear through the stitches on the second half of the ring. (Fig 4)
